Ka-ta'-ma nŭt o-ne'-pŭ-ha'-yil must not you not kill. None he did not kill she no-sĕmps'-kwŭl ma-lŭm'-ot ki-ska'-tŭm. O-ni'-si-wi-ti'-chĕl female bears until he was married. His wife o-ti-ho'-kol ŭn-kŭ-to'-pa no-sĕmpskw'; kŭ-tăt-su-i'-ne-pa'-tu-in she told him I want a taste a female bear; you must kill for me no-sĕmpskw'; ma-lum'-to o-tăt'-su-i-ne-pa'-tu-wa'-nŭl. a female bear; he killed for her. until Nit-we'-tche-ta-ke'-mŭk ka-ta'-ma o-ne'-pŭ-ha-u'-yŭl mu-in'-i-ŭl.
