A PROCLAMATION.

ROBERT BALDWIN, *Attorney General.* **W**HEREAS at a Session Proclamation
of the Parliament of
Our Province of Canada, holden at the City
of Montreal, in Our said Province, on the
Eighteenth day of January, in the year of
Our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and
forty-nine, and prorogued on the Thirtieth day
of May then next ensuing, in the twelfth year
of Our Reign, a certain Bill, intituled, *An Act
to incorporate the Toronto, Simcoe and Lake
Huron Union Rail-way Company*, was passed
by the Legislative Council and Assembly, and
was, at the prorogation of the said Session, on
the Thirtieth day of May aforesaid, presented
to Our Deputy Governor of Our said Province
