MAY NAME THE REGIMENT AFTER THE FIRST COLONEL

Suggestion Made at Unveiling of Portrait of Late Col. Davidson in Highlanders' Quarters.

That the name of the 48th Highlanders be changed to the Davidson Highlanders was the suggestion of Lieut.-Col. James Mason, late of the Royal Grenadiers, at the unveiling of a portrait of the late Col. John I. Davidson in the 48th officers' mess at the armory last night.

Lieut.-Col. D. M. Robertson promised to call an early meeting of the regimental executive to give consideration to the suggestion. He also promised "warmest consideration." The gathering was large and a tribute to the esteem in which the man who organized the regiment was held by the present staff of officers, by whose subscription the portrait was executed. E. W. Grier is the artist and has given a life-like presentation of the late Colonel Davidson in full regimental uniform, seated, with the great plumed bonnet in his lap.

Col. Robertson presided and the Union Jack was withdrawn from the painting by Col. Mason. The latter feelingly told of having been intimately connected with Col. Davidson, and he found difficulty in expressing his feelings on the occasion. The portrait would be something that every officer could well look upon as an inspiration of what was required of a soldier. The late John I. Davidson was a man who looked his fellow-man squarely in the face.

Brig.-Gen. Cotton considered it a privilege to attend the unveiling. Before coming to Toronto he had met Col. Davidson and had included him among his personal friends. Later he had had opportunity of sharing the late colonel's hospitality. His life and character was much appreciated and there could be no more fitting memorial to a gallant officer than to have a portrait placed in the private quarters of his fellow-officers.

Volunteers who spoke were: Dr. Kennedy, ex-president of St. Andrew's Society; Lieut.-Col. Percy Mason, Q. O. R.; Lieut.-Col. J. B. Maclean, Q. O. R.; Williams, N.C.D.; and Rev. T. Crawford, Drury, chaplain of the regiment. Regrets for inability to attend were read by Adjutant Darling from J. W. Langmuir, Alexander Fraser and D. MacGillivray of Halifax, a one-time captain of the regiment.

The inscription under the portrait reads: "Lieut. Col. John Irvine Davidson, first commanding officer of the 48th Regiment 'Highlanders', 1891-1896, hon. colonel 1898-1910."

Col. Davidson's son, David, was present at the ceremony, and it was announced that he is to enlist with the regiment this year, when he attains the age of 18.
