WALL-ST. MONEY EASIER. Stocks Quite Strong Again on New York Board.

Advances Yesterday in Many American Securities—Canadian Issues Quiet and Steady—Some Strength Showing in C.P.R. and Street Railway Issues—Notes and Gossip.

Liverpool futures were quiet to-day, the May option declining 1/2 cent and the July option closing at yesterday's final figure.

The prices of Chicago wheat futures to-day fluctuated over a range of nearly two cents. An early break of a cent was caused by realizing by holders, who looked up the Government crop report as being bullish in effect.

Liverpool maize futures were about steady to-day, with a lower tendency. Chicago corn ran up 1/2 cent per bushel and lost most of the advance before the close.

The receipts of flour and wheat at the nine Western primary markets during the week ending April 11 were 10,877 barrels flour, 8,786,278 bushels wheat, as compared with 125,284 barrels flour and 1,674,827 bushels wheat.

The Chicago Daily Bulletin reports an Argentine cable to The New York Herald estimating the Argentine crop at 100,000,000 bushels, but this report does not receive much credit.

A Continental exporter in New York wired his firm in Chicago that he was short of wheat, for the present.

U. S. Government Crop Report. A Washington advice to-day says: The weekly crop report of the weather bureau issued to-day says: The general condition of the crop continues improving, and the principal wheat producing states of the central valleys, on the Pacific Coast, the southern and western portions of California and Oregon, but in Washington much has been winter-killed, which, however, will be recovered.
