

From The Buffalo Commercial. The United States Department of Agriculture in a recent publication upon "The Rat Problem" assures us that this rodent destroys annually \$100,000,000 worth of grain. This statement is so astounding that were it not vouched for by experts in the biological survey little credence would be given it. These scientific men, however, have made an exhaustive study of the rat and they are quite scrious in urging an active campaign

to rid the country of this pest.

The most common and destructive member of the rodent family is the Norway rat, which has been carried in ships to the furthest corners of the earth, and has multiplied wherever it has landed. Rats live on almost anything that man eats, but they are especially ford of grain. These ro-dents are also destructive in killing young poultry and stealing eggs, and the pollution of food products causes as much loss as that which they con-

Their fecundity is remarkable. It is well, therefore, to call public attention to these facts as an incentive o renewed warfare against the pests Among measures suggested for their food by the disposal of garbage and the better protection by use of conthe better protection by use of concrete of our food supplies.
