

VESUVIUS STILL DEALING DEATH AND DESTRUCTION



THE CRATER OF VESUVIUS IN ERUPTION

Naples, April 10.—The volcano is continuing its activity, especially at Cercola. The stream of lava which started anew in the direction of the city of Naples, reached the cemetery of that town and then turned in the direction of Pompeii. The troops of the Neapolitan army, upon the activity of Mount Vesuvius, the hopefulness of the population, however, was short-lived, and a condition bordering on frenzy by the collapse of the Mount Oliveto market, which covered a space of about 200 feet square, the structure failed, and the crowd from the market, who were engaged in the work of rescue, were crushed and mangled beyond recognition. The scene in the vicinity of the ruins was most agonizing, relatives of the victims clamoring for help, and the cries of the dying. Only by the firm intervention of the police and carabinieri was it possible to keep the crowd from their death or from being engaged in the work of rescue. While early in the day the volcanic activity of Mount Vesuvius appeared to have diminished, as night approached, a prospect of immediate relief faded, and the scene in the vicinity of the ruins around the volcano seemed more hopeless. Instead of decreasing, the fall of sand and ash continued from the crater increased. Even with the sun shining high in the heavens the light was a dim yellow, and the air was thick with volcanic ash. The case of Torre Del Greco is typical. For thirty hours the place has been literally covered, and amid the ruins and a semi-darkness illuminated from time to time by vivid flashes of lightning, a few of the inhabitants go about hungry, with throats parched with smoke and dust, seemingly with their hands raised away from the ruins of what so recently were their homes. Communication by rail or tramway with Torre Del Greco and other towns is impossible owing to the cinders, sand and ash deposits. Railway travel to and from Naples is much hampered by the same conditions and a collision today resulted in the injury of 12 passengers. The case of Torre Del Greco is typical.
