### MOLDAVIA IS NOW THEATRE OF UNUSUAL WAR INTEREST

North Wing of Roumanian Kingdom Prize For Which Austro-Germans Are Battling With Great Intensity

With the Austro-German armies hammering at the gates of its defense on the north, and with Central Power forces attacking on the south, Moldavia, the northern wing of Roumania, which lies between the Carpathians on the west and the Pruth river on the east, promises to become a theatre of unusual war interest in the war immediately ahead. The following bulletin, issued by the National Geographic Society, gives to those following the course of the war from a geographic standpoint a picture that will enable them the better to interpret forthcoming movements in that part of the great chessboard of the world war.

Moldavia, the north wing of the butterfly-shaped kingdom of Roumania, has approximately one-fourth of the area of that country, the population being a little less than two and a quarter million and the area a little less than 15,000 square miles. To the west of it lies Transylvania, and the Austrian crown land of Bukovina. To the east lies Bessarabia, with the river Pruth marking the boundary the entire distance. On the south is Wallachia, the other wing of the Roumanian kingdom.

between the Pruth and the Sereth, is approximately 275 miles long and has an average width of about fifty miles. Western Moldavia is entirely mountainous, the crest of the Carpathians forming the boundary between it and Austria-Hungary. Generally speaking, the Central Powers' battle line on the south stretches from the intersection of the Pruth and the Sereth Rivers with the Danube, through Focsani, to the mountains.

There are more railroads in Moldavia than are usually found in southeastern Europe. One line enters along with the Sereth from Bukovina, and parallels that river all the way to Focsani. Another line enters through the Carpathians from Transylvania by way of the Gyimes Pass, and forms a junction with the Sereth river. Line some thirty miles above Focsani. A third line follows in a general way the River Pruth from the extreme northern end of Moldavia to its confluence with the Danube. In addition to these there are several branch lines, running at right angles to the main lines and providing excellent facilities for the movement of troops in any desired direction.

The history of the principality of Moldavia is of striking interest. It was founded about the middle of the 14th century by the Wallach Volvode Bogdan. It soon grew to be a large state, embracing the present Moldavia, Bukovina and Bessarabia. Poland and Hungary were both rivals for favor at the Moldavia court, with neither able permanently to assert its overlordship. Stephen the Great ruled Moldavia from 1457 to 1504, and defied the Turks, winning a signal victory over them at Rakova in 1475. Gradually growing stronger, however, the Moslems succeeded again, under Stephen the Great's successor, in establishing their mastery. "Although the Turks never settled the country, they proceeded to build fortresses and thus managed to hold their ground. "Up to 1821 the country was govern-

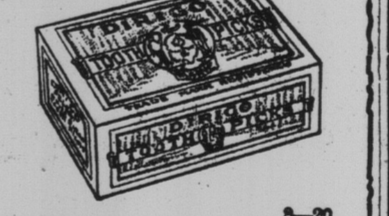
