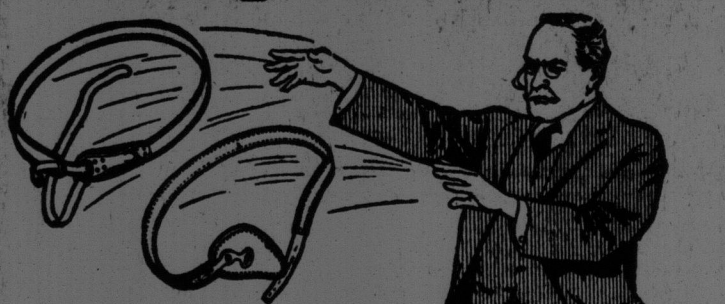

Hints for the Cook

Boston Favorite Cake

One-third cup butter, 1 cup sugar, 2 eggs, 1/2 cup milk, 1/4 cup flour, 1/2 cup raisins, 1/2 cup baking powder. Cream butter and sugar gradually, eggs beaten until light, then milk and flour mixed and sifted with baking powder. Beat well and pour into a buttered and floured pan. Bake in a moderate oven about 25 minutes. Frost with confectioner's frosting or chocolate frosting or it is good without frosting.

For Roast.

Season a solid piece of beef, either the round or vein, with salt and pepper. Dredge with flour. Brown in a frying pan with a small amount of fat. Place in a kettle, add one cup of boiling water, cover closely and cook in a slow oven until meat is tender. If the water cooks away, add just enough to keep meat from burning. Serve with hot brown gravy or tomato sauce.

Delicious Pie.

Line a deep plate with a rich crust, sprinkle crust with flour, then a layer of ten or twelve dates, stoned and cut in pieces. Fill plate with sliced nutmeg, three heaping tablespoons or more of sugar mixed with one spoonful of flour. Put on top crust and bake.

THIRTY-FOUR GERMAN SHIPS
SOLD THROUGH PRIZE-COURT

Detained in Home Ports or Captured at Sea and Taken to British Number 110—Some of the Sales.

Of 110 German merchant ships detained in British home ports or captured at sea and brought to British home ports up to the middle of March, thirty-four have been condemned to be sold, according to a table published by Shipping World. The prize court has ordered the detention of forty-five others. The highest price obtained so far was \$26,200 for the Schlesien. This vessel, which is of 5,586 tons gross, was the property of the Norddeutscher Lloyd and was bought by W. Thomas, Sons & Co., Ltd., of London. The lowest price was \$210 for the Berlin of seventy-nine tons gross.
