SLEEPING SICKNESS IS FATAL TO WOMAN

Mrs. Frances Cunningham, New Bedford, Victim-First Case in Southeastern Mass.
New Bedford, April 11-The first genuine case of "sleeping sickness," or leishmanic encephalitis, that is known to have occurred in the southeastern Massachusetts district, has resulted in the death of Mrs. Frances Cunningham, aged 55, here. Mrs. Cunningham had been ill for about two weeks. The attending physician, Dr. A. M. Salles, after consultation with Dr. S. E. local board, communicated with Dr. Eugene R. Kelley, state commissioner of health, who referred the matter to Dr. Charles W. Milliken, the district health officer, of Barnstable. Upon going to the house Dr. Milliken met Dr. Salles, Dr. A. N. Senesac, one of the medical inspectors for the local board, and Dr. A. H. Mandell, his bacteriologist, all of whom agreed in diagnosing the case as a typical one of "sleeping sickness." Of the cases previously reported in Massachusetts, one was from Boston and one from Brockton, but only one of these proved genuine. The disease is not entirely new to this country, some cases having followed the influenza epidemic in 1889-90. Mrs. Cunningham had an attack of influenza pneumonia in last January.
