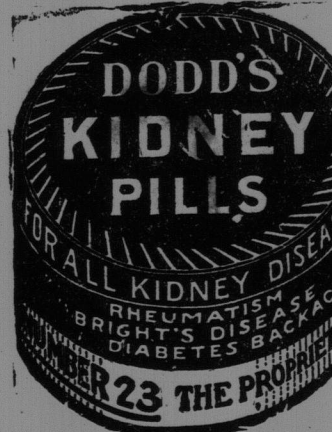

DROWNED IN THE MARSH CREEK

Harry Smith, Aged Nineteen Year, Meets Untimely Death—Pulmotor Used But Without Success

Harry Smith, nineteen years of age, an expressman who delivers parcels for purchasers in the city market, was drowned in the Marsh creek about 4.30 o'clock yesterday afternoon. After bathing with his two cousins, Smith was sitting on the bank washing the mud from his feet when he slipped in. The two youngsters started for help and brought Policeman Ralph Dykeman and a crowd of people to the scene. The body was recovered by Mark Breen and the pulmotor sent for and although nearly two tanks of oxygen were used, resuscitation was impossible. Dr. F. L. Kenny, the coroner has decided that no inquest is necessary. Mr. Smith is survived by his mother, Mrs. L. Campbell, of Hoyt Station, and an uncle, George Anderson, 216 Brussels street. He resided with Mrs. Sabina, 60 Erin street.
