The most notable utterance was made by Dr. von Heydebrand, the leader of the Government Conservative party, who is sometimes called the "uncrowned King of Prussia."

Pointing his finger at the Chancellar, who was seated only a yard away, Dr. von Heydebrand declared that the bold avowal of the Socialists in favor of a republic, which the country had heard, made it imperative that he (the Chancellor) should not wait for the arrival of the revolution, but should take immediately such steps as would nip it in the bud.

The appeal of the Conservative leader to the Imperial Chancellor is regarded as forecasting an attempt to secure the renewal of Bismarck's anti-Socialist laws, for the purpose of suppressing all forms of the Socialist propaganda.

Rome, Nov. 28.—The Osservatore Romano publishes comments, evidently inspired by the Vatican, on the discussion Saturday in the German Reichstag of the speech made by Emperor William at Koenigsberg on Aug. 26, pointing out that the debate furnished proof of the irrefutable truth, contained in the Emperor's speeches both at Koenigsberg and Beuron, that the throne and altar cannot be divided in Germany, religion being necessary in the struggle against error in modern times. In addressing the abbot and a number of Roman Catholic dignitaries in the Benedictine Monastery at Beuron, the Emperor said: "The Governments of Christian princes can only be carried on according to the will of the Lord. The attar and throne are closely united, and must not be separated."

The Vatican official organ, in the course of its comment, says: "The two finest speeches of the German monarch were noble, just and constitutionally correct. While irreligion and domagogy imperil the principles of authority and order, it is a relief to hear certain truths nobly vindicated by the authoritative and august lips of a powerful sovereign."
