THE DOBRUBSCHA.

The Stratagette Points it Offers for a Russian Invasion of Bulgaria.

The Dobrudscha is the natural route for the Russian forces, if the Czar should decide to send an army into Bulgaria to drive prince Ferdinand from the throne.

The Dobrudscha proper is a low and the Black sea. It belonged to Turkey be fore the late Russo-Turkish war, and was then regarded as forming part of the province of Bulgaria. It was transferred from Turkey to Roumania by the treaty of Berlin in 1878, and with it went a strip of territory some 25 miles broad, running from Trajan's wall to a line drawn from the old fortress of Silistria on the Danube, to the port of Mangalia, on the Black sea. The whole district is now classed geographically as the Roumanian province of the Dobrudscha. It is about 100 miles long, while the breadth ranges from 30 to 70 miles. Including the islands in the delta of the Danube, it has an area of some 6000 square miles and a population a little under 400,000.
