0.376 What did you say to the driver when you drew his attention? A.376 I just told him to haul it over I thought he was going in the ditch. Q.377 Did you raise your voice? A.377 No, I didn't holler I just spoke to him. PROSECUTOR: Well if you didn't speak any louder than you are now I would not hear you. 9.378 What about the little boy, what was he doing all this time? A.378 Well, he was sitting on my lap, he wasn't doing much of anything at the time. Q.379 Awake or asleep? A.379 No, he was awake. Q.380 Did you see any other traffic on the road that night? A.380 The only thing passed us, Sir, passed going to St. Stephen was the bus. Q.381 And when did that pass - that bus pass you? A.381 It was due in St. Stephen at 12 o'clock. Q.382 I mean how far from St. Stephen? A.382 I couldn't say, Sir. 0.382 How long before the accident was that? A.382 Well, right after the bus passed us, that was about 12, shortly after the bus passed. 0.383 How long? A.383 I couldn't say, Sir, I didn't have no watch. 0.384 How long would you estimate?

I would estimate 10 or 15 minutes, Sir.
