4. MEDALS AND SCHOLARSHIPS.

In 1865 the "Holmes Gold Medal" was founded by the Faculty of Medicine as a memorial of the late Andrew Holmes, Esq., M.D., LL.D., late Dean of the Faculty of Medicine, to be given to the best student in the graduating class in Medicine, who should undergo a special examination in all the branches, whether Primary or Final.

In 1878 the "Sutherland Gold Medal" was founded by Mrs. Sutherland of Mon-
treal, in memory of her late husband, Prof. William Sutherland, M.D., for
competition in the classes of Theoretical and Practical Chemistry in the
Faculty of Medicine, together with creditable standing in the Primary Ex-
aminations

THE DAVID MORRICE SCHOLARSHIP—in the subject of Institutes of Medicine, in the
Faculty of Medicine—founded in 1881—value, \$100. (Terminated in 1883.)
