MEETING OF MUNICIPALITY EXCELSIOR

The Seventh regular meeting of the Rural Municipality of Excelsior No. 166 was held at the Municipal Office Rush Lake on Tuesday, July 8, 1919, with the Reeve and all Councillors present. Moved by McCann that minutes of last meeting be adopted as read. Carried.

Moved by Reeve Friesen that Councillor Unger communicate with Mr. Klassen re petition for road between sections 18 and 19 in township 19, range 10, West 3rd. Carried.

Moved by Wilson that Court of Revision to hear assessment appeals pertaining to Townships 18, 19 and 20, range 13, East of Swift Current Creek be held August 5th. Carried.

Moved by McCann that map submitted by Sask. Land Municipality showing acreage comprised in townships 18, 19 and 20, range 13, East of Creek be accepted. Carried.

Moved by Reeve Friesen that all old lease taxes against lands now sold be abstracted from roll and placed to a suspense account, and sanction to do so be obtained from the Dept. of Municipal Affairs. Carried.

Moved by Unger that The Dept. of Highways be requested to build the following bridges on N.E. 25-19-11-3, on grade North of Rush Lake and East of S.E. 21-16-12-3, and also that an appropriation of \$1500.00 be spent on road East of 25-19-11-3. Carried.

Moved by Funk that road committee in company with Mr. Gehman examine and investigate the advantages of making and buying a roadway through 29-17-10-3. Carried.

Moved by McCann that petition for cancellation of road through S.W. 15-16-10-3 be refused and no steps taken to change same. Carr'd.

Moved by Unger that the municipality purchase land for diversion on N.W. 1/4 of 18-18-10-3 and compensation be guaranteed. Carried.

Moved by Wilson that road be surveyed on North side of sections 2 and 3 in 17-12-3, also small diversion on N.E. 1/4 11-17-12-3 and compensation guaranteed, and that previous motion respecting same be rescinded. Carried.

Moved by Funk that diversion be surveyed on S.W. 1-19-12-3 and compensation guaranteed. Carried.

Moved by McCann that F. I. Doell be allowed ten dollars for moving his fence on S.E. 22-18-12-3. Carried.

Moved by McCann that road committee investigate and report at next meeting respecting diversion required on N.W. 34-16-11-3. Carried.

Moved by Reeve Friesen that whereas this municipality has Seed Grain Liens outstanding of about \$8,000.00, and whereas this fund constitutes public money, and whereas the security covering the loans is precarious, therefore be it resolved that this Council hereby petitions The Government to immediately take steps to place the

WANT TURKISH OFFICERS EXTRADITED

PARIS.—The newspapers of Constantinople assert that the Turkish government has decided to ask the entente to permit the extradition of Talaat Bey, Enver Pasha and Djemal Bey, leaders in the Turkish government during the war.

Talaat Bey, Enver Pasha and Djemal Bey were condemned to death on July 11, in default of their appearance by the Turkish court-martial which has been investigating the conduct of the Turkish government during the period of the war. The three men are now in Germany.

FAREWELL ADVICE HANDED TO BRITAIN BY GENERAL SMUTS

LONDON, England.—Lieut-Gen. Smuts of the Union of South Africa, and member of the British peace delegation, in a farwelled message, advocates appeasement and reconciliation with Germany and encouragement of the present moderate administration in Germany, which is successfully fighting the European battle against anarchy.

Gen. Smuts strongly urges leaving Russia to settle her own affairs, on the ground "that a sobered soviet system may be better than barbarism, to which the present policy seems inevitably to be tending," and declares that British statesmen should apply the same medicine to Ireland that they applied to Bohemia.

SIX BURNED IN FIRE

MALONE, N. Y.—Six persons were burned to death in a fire that destroyed the home of Lee Hurteau, as Messina.

The dead are: Mrs. Lee Hurteau and two children, Hectorine, aged 15, and Earl, three years old; Mrs. Ernest Amell of Cornwall, Ont., a sister of Mr. Hurteau, and her two children, Lionel, 9, and Harold, aged 7.

"I have no faith in the regeneration of the Germans," said Mr. Massey, when he reached Vancouver. He emphasized his distrust of any lasting improvement in the defeated enemy by giving it as his opinion that German chemists would be at work soon, if they were not already at work devising new methods of destruction for use when the proper time arrives. The most serious mistake made with regard to the conclusion of peace, in the opinion of the speaker, was in not dictating a victorious peace on the soil of Germany.
