NOTICE TO PRODUCERS IN THE AROOSTOOK DISTRICT LOOK FOR STILL HIGHER PRICES

Maurice E. Dickinson of this City Returns from Maine—Crop Fair and Selling at \$2.75 a Barrel—Potato Kings Summoned to Washington.

The potato growers of Aroostook county look for higher prices for their crop instead of lower during the coming fall months, notwithstanding the enormous surplus in the United States at large this season.

Maurice E. Dickinson, of Germain street, who with Mrs. Dickinson, has just returned from a ten days' automobile tour of that prosperous region, said last evening that the farmers in the potato section of Maine were receiving \$2.75 per barrel, but expected to get more before a great while. The digging season is now at its height but the crop is only fair, Mr. Dickinson says.

A dispatch from Washington says that five prominent potato kings of Aroostook county have gone to the capital in response to a summons from Herbert C. Hoover, food controller. The big buyers and growers of the great Maine centres are the first potato men called by the national food administrator in a campaign to forestall speculation in this year's crop and to prevent a repetition of the conditions that obtained last fall, when the United States was forced to buy \$10,000,000 worth of potatoes from Aroostook county alone.

Big growers and buyers from other parts of the country will follow the visit of the Maine men to Washington. It has been estimated that Aroostook county will receive only \$20,000,000 this year for its crop, but time will tell.

Synopsis of Canadian North-west Land Regulations.

The sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, who has served in the military or naval forces of the present war, and has since continued to be a British subject, may homestead a quarter-section of available position land in the Northwest Territories, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Ontario, Quebec, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island, and Newfoundland. Entry by proxy may be made on certain conditions.

In certain districts a homesteader may secure a homestead on a portion of an acre, or more, of land in the Northwest Territories, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Ontario, Quebec, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island, and Newfoundland. Entry by proxy may be made on certain conditions.

A settler after obtaining homestead patent if he cannot secure a pre-emption, may lease a 100 acre tract in certain districts. Price \$1.00 per acre. Must reside on the land for six months and cultivate 20 acres and erect
