PANET, *Lieut.-Col. Hon. LOUIS, N.P.* [*La Salle.*]

S. of the late Hon. J. A. Panet, for many years Speaker of the Leg. Assem. of L. Can., and a member of the Leg. Council of L. Can. B. at Quebec. M. Miss Oliva, dau. of Dr. Oliva, of St. Thomas, P.Q. Is Lieut.-Col. commanding 1st Batt. Quebec Militia. Sat as a life mem. in Leg. Coun., Can., from Oct. 1852 until the Union. Appointed to present House, 1867.—*St. Lewis St., Quebec.*

PROULX, *Hon. JEAN BAPTISTE GEORGE.* [*De La Vallière.*]

Sat for De La Vallière in the L. C., Can., from 1860 until the Union. Called to present House, 1867.—*Nicolet, P.Q.*

PRUD'HOMME, *Hon. J, EUSTACHE.* [*Rigaud.*]

Sat for Rigaud, in L. C., Can., from 1863 until the Union. Called to present House, 1867.—*Tannery West, P.Q.*

RODIER, *Hon. CHARLES SERAPHIN.* [*De Lorimier.*]

Called to the Bar, L. C., 1841. Has been Mayor and a Harbour Commissioner of Montreal.
