An Act further to amend the Criminal Code, 1892.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. Article 941 of *The Criminal Code, 1892*, is hereby 1892, c. 29,
5 repealed and the following substituted therefor:— new s. 941.

“**941.** Any justice of the peace for the district, county or place to which the prison belongs, and such relatives of the prisoner as it seems to the sheriff proper to admit within the prison for the purpose, and any journalist and any minister of religion who desires to attend, may also be present at the execution.” Who may be present at executions.
