Authorize the Legislature of the Province of make Provision concerning the Canada to Clergy Reserves in that Province, and the Proceeds thereof.

HEREAS the Act of the Session of Parliament holden in the Preamble. Third and Fourth Years of Her Majesty, Chapter Seventy- 3 & 4 Vict. eight, provides for the Sale of the Lands called Clergy Reserves in the Province of Canada, and for the Distribution of the 5 Proceeds thereof; and it is expedient that the Legislature of the said Province should be enabled to make further Provisions in relation to such Reserves and Proceeds: Be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament 10 assembled, and by the Authority of the same, as follows:

I.
