TO

Authorize the Legislature of the Province of Canada to make Provision concerning the Clergy Reserves in that Province, and the Proceeds thereof.

WHEREAS the Act of the Session of Parliament holden in the Third and Fourth Years of Her Majesty, Chapter Seventy-eight, provides for the Sale of the Lands called Clergy Reserves in the Province of Canada, and for the Distribution of the Proceeds thereof; and it is expedient that the Legislature of the said Province should be enabled to make further Provisions in relation to such Reserves and Proceeds: Be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, as follows :

I. It shall be lawful for the Legislature of the Province of Canada, from Time to Time, by any Act or Acts to be for that Purpose made and enacted in the Manner and subject to the Conditions required by the Act of the said Session of Parliament holden in the Third and Fourth Years of Her Majesty, Chapter Thirty-five, Sections Thirty-seven and Thirty-eight, in respect of Acts made and enacted by such Legislature, to vary or repeal all or any of the Provisions of the said

The Legislature of Canada may alter the Appropriation of the Clergy Reserves and the Proceeds thereof.
