

subject shortly after the Act in question had become law, asking you to consult with the Indians and to learn their mind in respect to the Indian Advancement Act being made applicable to their Band.

The instructions given you in my letter of the 30th Ullimo are apparently correct, being in consistency with the existing law applicable to Indian Bands and Reserves generally within the Dominion.
