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OTTAWA, 19th June, 1903

Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 13th instant in which you bind yourself to continue the education of your son Lawrence at a more advanced school than the one at Wikwemikong, for at least three years, and furnish the Department with quarterly certificates of his attendance and progress. You also agree not to call upon the Department to pay any part of the cost of his education after he leaves to Wikwemikong.

In reply I beg to inform you that this agreement meets the wishes of the Department and instructions have been issued to Rev. Father Paquin, Principal of Wikwemikong Industrial school, to grant your son's discharge and provide his transport to Caughnawaga.
