Sir,-

Referring to your letter of the 14th instant accompanying tracings of the right of way of the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway through Muscowequan Indian reserve, No. 85, I am returning these tracing under separate cover for amendment.

I beg to state that this reserve was subdivided into sections by the Department of the Interior prior to being set aside as an Indian reserve. As it is described by sections in the Book of Reserves, it will be necessary for you to furnish a right of way plan similar to that through an ordinary subdivided Township showing the areas taken from each quarter section. The roads are not part of the Indian reserve. I enclose you a copy of the plan of the reserve.
