The Department proposes to order these drugs from Lymans Limited, of Montreal, and I would request you to give the address in each case with shipping directions.

No requisitions have been received for Fort Ros and Fort Norman, but it is understood that these missions did not ask for any medicines for this year and that they are well supplied.
