

if the testing of the ground, which will take about two months, is satisfactory the plant we propose to instal will be able to deal with 50 cubic yards per hour and it will take such a plant 10 years or over to deal with the material on the said 100 acres. It will therefore work out to be quite an industry.

The Indians, the Provincial Government, a considerable force of men engaged in the work as well as the general public and ourselves will all benefit by the carrying on of such an industry and it would seem somewhat regrettable if the above or some other solution cannot be found for the difficulty that will allow the work to be undertaken.

The others involved with me in the proposal see the season passing when they should like to be at it and are getting impatient to start and please therefore give it your consideration and reply as soon as possible.
