

Question to the accused.

Do you object to be tried by me as President of the Court ?

Answer:

"No Sir"

(N.B. If objection is made it should be recorded together with the decision of the Court on a separate page marked "B B" and attached immediately under Page B.)

Question to the accused.

Do you object to as interpreter ?

Answer:

AD

Question to the accused.

Do you object to as shorthand writer ?

Answer:

"No Sir"

The shorthand writer and interpreter (if any) are duly sworn.

Question to the prosecutor.

Has the accused elected to be tried by a Standing Court-Martial or other Court-Martial ?

Answer:

"No, the accused was committed for trial"

The accused is arraigned upon each charge in the Charge Sheet marked B-2, and annexed to the proceedings after having been signed by the President.

Question to the accused.
Answer by accused.

Is that your number, rank, name and unit ?

"Yes Sir"

Question to the accused.

Are you guilty or not guilty of the (first) charge against you, which you have heard read ?

Answer:

"Not guilty Sir"

Question to the accused.

Are you guilty or not guilty of the second charge against you, which you have heard read ?

Answer:

"Not guilty Sir"

Question to the accused.

Are you guilty or not guilty of the third charge against you, which you have heard read ?

Answer:
