SIR:

I have the honor to refer to your note of this date proposing, on behalf of the Government of Canada, that the Air Transport Agreement between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of Canada of January 17, 1966, be amended in certain respects. Your note also proposes an understanding that both Governments should continue to recognize certain practices as encompassed by the Agreement.

I have the honor to inform you that the proposals contained in your note, which is authentic in English and French, are acceptable to my Government and to confirm that your note together with this reply shall constitute an agreement which enters into force on today's date.
