Article I.

This Club shall be called the Argonaut Name.

Article II.

fessional for a prize; who has never at any
period of his life taught or assisted in the
pursuit of any athletic exercise or sport as a
means of livelihood; who has never, directly
or indirectly, received any bonus, or any
money consideration whatever, for any ser-
vices rendered as an athlete, excepting his
actual traveling or hotel expenses; who has
never entered into any competition under a
name other than his own, or has never been
guilty of selling or pledging his prizes.
