

member; notify the members of all meetings; keep copies of all letters written and files of all received; sign all certificates of membership; collect all fees for membership, and pay over the same to the Treasurer, taking his receipt; and shall perform such other duties in connection with the Association as the Managing Committee may direct.

ARTICLE XI.—EXPULSION.

Any member who may have been guilty of ungentlemanly conduct shall be liable to expulsion, and may be expelled by a two-thirds vote of the members present at a meeting of the Association specially called for that purpose, as provided in Article vi., Sec. 3. Seven days' previous notice by registered letter shall also be given the member concerned.

ARTICLE XII —AMENDMENT, REPEAL, &C.

This Constitution may be amended or repealed by a two-thirds vote of the members present at a regular meeting or a special meeting called for that purpose; provided that one week's notice of such amendment or repeal has been given by circular mailed to each member, or that notice in writing of such amendment or repeal has been given at a previous general meeting of the Association; and further provided, nothing in this article contained shall be deemed to prevent any amendment or amendments, relevant to such amendment or appeal, being regularly moved, seconded and dealt with at such meeting.
