

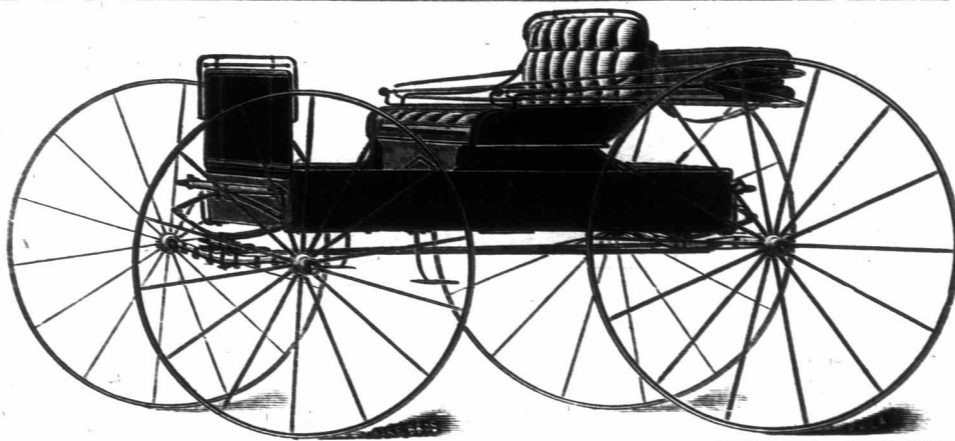

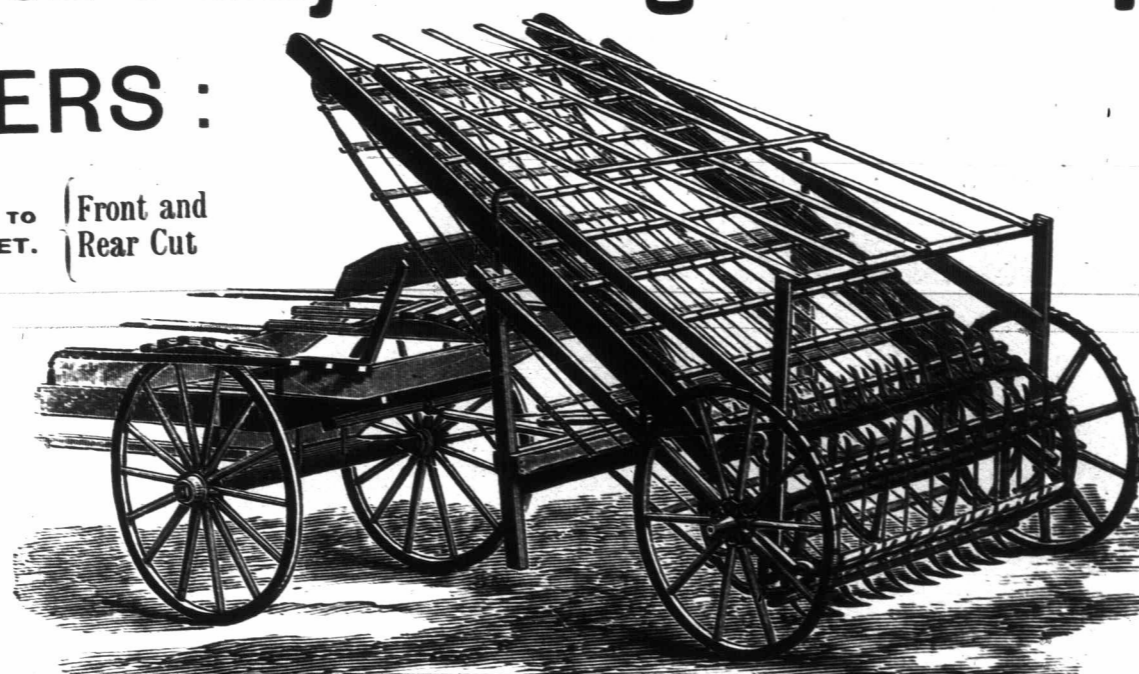

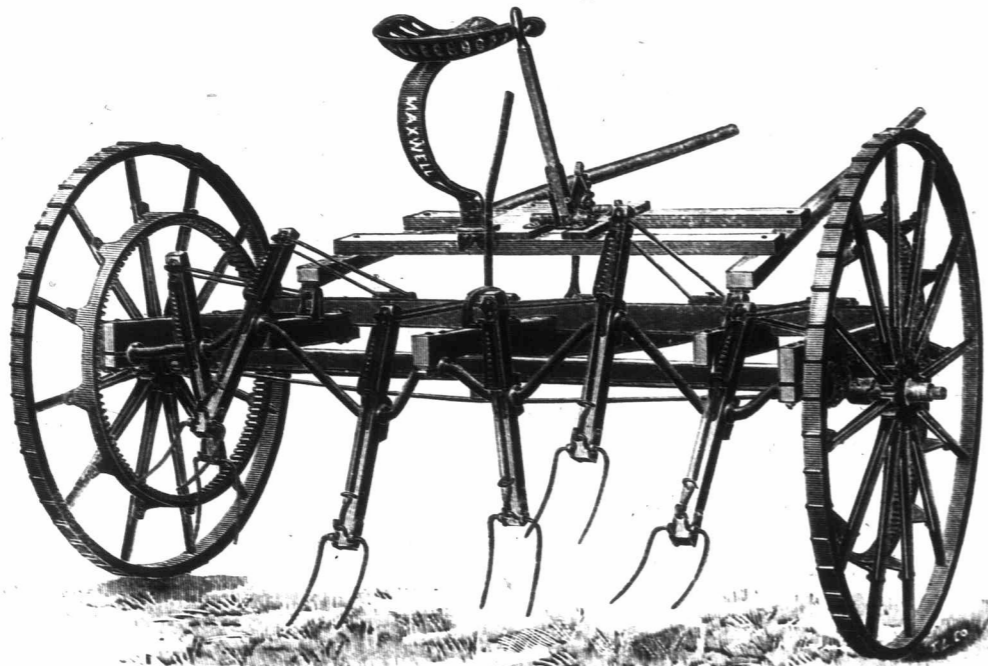

BINDER TWINE from the Central Prison, for the season of 1900, will be sold to FARMERS or FARMERS' CLUBS for their own use in any quantity, from one bale to any number required, at the following prices per lb.: "Extra Standard," in bales of 50 lbs. each, \$ 1-2c. "Farmers' Special," in bales of 60 lbs. each, 1 1/2c. Cash must accompany every order, or be received before twine is shipped; freight in all cases must be paid by purchaser, and orders will be accepted for full bales only. In cases where a farmer orders a greater quantity than is required for his own use, the order must be signed by the persons joining in the order, and the amount required by each must accompany it, as well as the Post Office address of each applicant. The twine is well manufactured, every pound guaranteed of serviceable quality, and if any prove faulty in use, on being returned money will be refunded. "Extra Standard" is held only in small quantity, but "Farmers' Special," which will prove of special value to farmers using it, is in liberal supply. Orders addressed to "The Warden, Central Prison, Toronto," will receive prompt attention.
