RUINS OF ASSOS.

Some German papers gave an interesting account of the excavations which have been carried on at the site of Assos, one of the oldest cities of Asia Minor.

It is mentioned in the Salier papyrus among the auxiliaries of the Hittites, at Kadash, on the Orontes, against Rhameses the Great, 1490 years B. C. It was built on a steep hill, of volcanic origin, south of the Trojan plain, well protected by its position from hostile attacks, and seems to have been inhabited by a purely Greek population far down into our era.
