Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for granting to His Majesty, additional and "new Duties on Goods, Wares and Merchandizes and for appropriating the " same towards further defraying the charges of the administration of Justice and " support of the Civil Government within this Province and for other purposes " therein mentioned," as relates to the allowance or abatement of Duty of one penny half-penny, for every pound avoirdupois weight, of all Roll and Carrot Tobacco, manufactured within the Cities of Quebec and Montreal, and Town of Three Rivers, and the respective Suburbs and Banlieus of the said Cities, and Town, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Rates and Ducollected under the same Rules

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the several Rates der this Act to and Duties so before recited, in this Act, shall be raised, levied, collected and paid in the same manner and form, and under the same Rules and Regulations, Penalties and Forfeitures, as are by Law now established in this Province, for the cetablished by levying and collecting of other Rates and Duties.

The amount of General.

IV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the amount of Duties to be the aforesaid Rates and Duties, so collected and levied, together with all such by the Collec- Penalties and Forfeitures, as shall be incurred by virtue of this Act, shall be ac-tor and paid to the Receiver counted for, and paid by the respective Collector or Collectors thereof, in same Penalties and Forfeitures, as shall be incurred by virtue of this Act, shall be acmanner and form, as by law established in this Province in regard to other Rates and Duties, to the Receiver General for the use of His Majesty, his Heirs and Successors, towards further defraying the charges of the Civil Government of this Province ; and the application thereof shall be accounted for to his Majesty through the Lords Commissioners of his Majesty's Treasury, in such manner and form as his Hajesty, his Heirs and Successors shall direct.
