FAMINE IN ALASKA

Seattle, Wash., Oct. 15.—Because of the damage the power schooner Ruby and forced it to return without reaching the Kushkukwin River section of Alaska with cargo of supplies, several thousand miners and prospectors of that section are threatened with famine before winter fairly sets in, according to the Ruby's master, Captain McAlpine, who has arrived here. The Ruby was the only ship sent to the Kushkukwin section last summer and it is believed to be too late for another vessel to make the trip this year.
