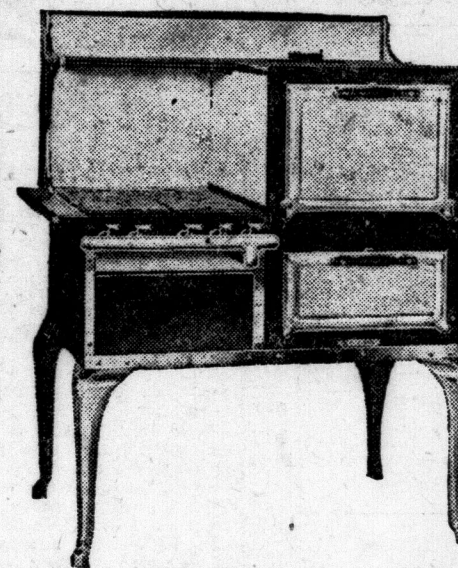
W. M. S. Meeting.
