CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS.

15:

6. A question may be reconsidered at any time by a two-thirds' vote of those present.

7. No member shall speak more than once on any question, except the proposer, or in explanation, and no new matter shall be introduced in such explanation.

8. All elections shall be by ballot, and superintended, and ballots counted, by scrutineers appointed by the Chairman.

9. All other voting shall be open unless the presiding officer shall be requested by at least five members that the vote should be by ballot.

10. Reports of Committees other than reports of progress shall be in writing signed by some officer of the Committee. Reports of Delegates may be verbal.

11. Any member may in any point appeal to the meeting from the decision of the chair. The Chairman shall then put the question, "Shall the decision of the chair be sustained?"

12. The Association may, by a three-quarters vote at any meeting suspend any specified rule of order.
