9. **THE CLEW OF THE MAZE AND THE SPARE HALF-HOUR.** By C. H. SPURGEON. Price 15 cents. The name of Spurgeon as author is about as good a recommendation as a book can have now-a-days. If any other were needed in this case, it is found in the subject treated—Modern Unbelief, the Agnosticism of the day. He handles it without gloves, and in that striking, homely way that carries conviction to both heart and mind. Spurgeon's illustrations are something renowned on two continents. They abound in all simplicity and force in this little work. They reach all readers, learned and unlearned. The best single phrase we know of to express the character of the entire book is, its "uncommon common-sense." It is not a work simply for scholars; it is for everybody, and most of all for those who have done the least reading of this sort. "The Spare Half-Hour" is a series of most engaging and instructive papers, suggested by the author's travels on the continent.
8. **IN THE HEART OF AFRICA.** Condensed from the works of SIR SAMUEL W. BAKER, F.R.G.S. Price 25 cents. In this condensation much of the dry scientific record has been omitted, but the unity and thrilling charm of the narrative have been well preserved, as well as the instructive descriptions of the natives and countries observed. Of especial interest just now are the chapters on the Soudan, and its capital, Khartoum.
