## ARTICLE III

(1) The Parties shall encourage and facilitate co-operation between persons under their respective jurisdictions on matters within the scope of this Agreement.

(2) Subject to the terms of this Agreement, persons under the jurisdiction of either Party may supply to or receive from persons under the jurisdiction of the other Party nuclear material, material, equipment and technology, on commercial or other basis as may be agreed by the persons concerned.

(3) Subject to the terms of this Agreement, persons under the jurisdiction of either Party may provide persons under the jurisdiction of the other Party with technical training in the application of nuclear energy for peaceful uses on commercial or other basis as may be agreed by the persons concerned.

(4) The Parties will make efforts to facilitate exchanges of experts, technicians and specialists related to activities under this Agreement.

(5) The Parties shall take all precautions necessary to preserve the confidentiality of information including commercial and industrial secrets transferred between persons under the jurisdiction of either Party.

(6) The Parties may, subject to terms and conditions to be jointly determined, collaborate on safety and regulatory aspects of the production of nuclear energy including (a) exchange of information and (b) technical co-operation and training.

(7) A Party shall not use the provisions of this Agreement for the purpose of securing commercial advantage or for the purpose of interfering with the commercial relations of the other Party.

(8) The cooperation under this Agreement shall be in accordance with the laws, regulations, and policies in force in Canada and in the Czech Republic.
