The Oueen and The Duke of Edinburgh and members of their party enter the Legislative Buildings and proceed to the second floor.

The Oueen is escorted to her suite by Mrs. Mooney and Mrs. Manning.

The Duke of Edinburgh is escorted to the Lieutenant-Governor's suite by the Lieutenant-Governor and the Premier.

(Other members of Party proceed to Speaker's suite).

12.30 p.m. The Queen and The Duke of Edinburgh and members of the Royal Party meet in the Legislative Chamber and descend the main staircase, pass through the Library and enter balcony at south side of building. When Her Majesty appears on the balcony the band plays "God Save The Queen".

> The Royal Party leaves the balcony and descends to the garden where a buffet luncheon is served.

> Following the luncheon the Premier presents members of the government, and the Speaker of the House and their wives.

The Queen and The Duke of Edinburgh leave 2.00 p.m. Government grounds by south gate for C.N.R. Station. (The Mayor and Mrs. Hawrelak re-join the motorcade.)
