

# Notes

The 1990-1992 Road Project, US\$28.0 million, is being implemented by the Ministry of Transport, Government of Guyana. The project objectives are public sector reform, budgetary reform, private sector development, the development of improved road standards, the reduction of disparities between urban and rural areas, the reduction of road to poor population, these objectives will be realized through improving maintenance of rural roads, particularly repaired roads, decentralizing road management responsibilities to local governments, without developing new entities, strengthening a link between budget and road classification, strengthening budgetary discipline, transparency and accountability, improving specific road maintenance levels for execution by contract to improve efficiency and to create new development opportunities for a dynamic private sector, and finally minimizing life-cycle costs by seeking optimum use of fixed road resources. The project is still in the start-up phase.
