

And still a little further, it says:

A little further, there is caricature of the Mayor of Montreal with the following caption:

A scare-crow to knock down!

FRAP sympathizers are requested to knock down the scare-crow of the city of Montreal. Further, there is a description of the political programme of FRAP, an organization which is fighting for municipal election in Montreal.

On another page, there are four heads with these words:

—always aim at the head and aim at the right one.

In effect, the heads are those of the President of the United States, Mr. Nixon, of the Prime Minister of Canada, of the Premier of Quebec and of the Mayor of the city of Montreal.

“Always aim at the head and aim at the right one.” A parallel is drawn between the situation in Quebec and the one that existed in May 1968 in Paris. Further, students who have acted like men are congratulated. It also says:

The Boston police is looking for four militant students suspected of a \$26,000 holdup at the State Street Bank and Trust Co.

But here is the most surprising thing of all: an advertisement covering 45 per cent of a page of the magazine was paid by the Public Service Commission of Canada, with the Canadian taxpayers' money, to support such a revolutionary magazine.

On page 33, individuals who would like to earn \$60 to \$80 per week are invited to show a film to Quebecers twice a night.

On the last page but one, we find ourselves in the year 2010. It says:

The PQ was right.

And there is the picture of René Lévesque who in 2010 will be 88 years of age.

Mr. Speaker, I would like to establish a relation between the methods and the aims, as published in *Le Quartier Latin*.

The report submitted to the federal government by the authorities of the city of Montreal with regard to the Company of Young Canadians has been simply ignored.

The revolutionary methods that are being advocated in all university papers across Quebec are exactly the same as those drawn to our attention by the city of Montreal authorities in a report submitted to the federal government last year.

The government of the time, which is the same one as today's, had been fully warned of all that was going to happen in Quebec, but unfortunately the worst is still to come. It had been forewarned by the Chairman of the

Who therefore has played a double game in Ottawa and has ordered to ignore the report which outlined coming dangers and events?

Who therefore in Ottawa pretends to be on the side of democracy by denouncing terrorists while at the same time not taking the necessary steps to avoid revolution and prevent events such as those we have just witnessed?

Some things in Ottawa make me wonder.

For a year and a half, the Canadian authorities had been having talks aimed at the official recognition of Communist China. And, in the House, the Secretary of State for External Affairs (Mr. Sharp) kept telling us that the discussions were proceeding and that no agreement had been reached.

Now, Mr. Speaker, I believe much more in planning than in coincidence. How is it that right after Mr. James Cross' kidnapping, namely the day after, and when the whole Canadian population had this event in mind and everybody was greatly disturbed, the government took advantage of the collective psychological tension of the Canadian people to announce the official recognition of Communist China?

The people of Shefford and the Canadian people do not mind the lack of cultural relations with Communist China. The FLQ made everybody feel edgy but the events it has created have helped the Canadian government to get the recognition of Communist China down the Canadian people's throat.

We shall soon see hundreds of embassy attachés from Communist China walking through the streets of the main Canadian cities and to do what? First, visit all the Canadian Chinese and convince them of the greatness of the Peking government. Second, they will indoctrinate these people then start the implementation of the strategies dictated by Communist China's government. We will then have to face the experts of a government that achieved power through more sophisticated and better financed methods than those of the FLQ members.

Reading from the little red book entitled *War Weapon*, a valuable document in China, I would like to quote practical advice given by world revolutionaries. At page 147 it is said about Robert Williams, an American terrorist:

—He made a trip to Cuba and returned a fanatic supporter of Fidel Castro. In 1961, during a racial demonstration in Monroe, Williams killed a policeman, then kidnapped a white couple to use them as hostages. To evade the law, he fled to Cuba where he was welcomed as a hero. He worked for Havana radio from where he broadcast to the United States delirious calls to terrorism and riots—

From there he went to Communist China where he now lives and publishes *The Crusader*—

Through that publication, he directs Chinese communist infiltration in other countries throughout the world. I resume the quotation:

In the June 1964 issue of *The Crusader*, Williams wrote, “The weapons used by the fighters for Afro-American freedom must
