Resolved, That in order to assist the Montreal Harbour Commissioners in the improvement of the Navigation of the St. Lawrence below Montreal it is expedient to amend the Act Thirty-sixth Victoria, Chapter Sixty, by providing that the rate of interest payable by the said Harbour Commissioners to the Receiver General upon the sums raised under the said Act shall be four per cent. per annum, instead of five, and further by repealing the provisions in the said Act contained, relating to payments by the said Harbour Commissioners for the formation of a Sinking Fund.
