are eligible as members of the Association, and together with the other three Directors, Secretary and Treasurer, shall reside in the Local Division wherein the Head Board of Directors is established. The said Board of Directors shall be elected to hold office for one year. The Secretary and the Treasurer of the Head Board of Directors shall receive an annual remumeration for their services as provided by By-Laws. The members of the local boards of management shall be elected annually, on from each of the departments of Customs, Inland Revenue and Post office, provided that each of the departments is represented in the membership of the local division and they shall be members of the Association, and reside in the local division for which they are elected.

SEC. 6.—To facilitate the supervision and management of the Association, the Inland Revenue Divisions as they are now constituted, or as they may hereafter be defined, shall constitute the local divisions in which local boards of management shall be established and

have jurisdiction.

SEC, 7.—The Association shall have the power to make and adopt By-Laws for the administration of the property and affairs of the Association, and for the admission of members and the cancellation of members' certificates, and also to repeal and amend the Constitu-

tion and By-Laws.

SEC. 8.—That there shall be a Permanent Fund formed, which shall not at any time exceed the sum of twenty thousand dollars of lawful money of Canada, which fund shall be raised from moneys received, being members' entrance fees, subscriptions and donations as hereinafter described; the said moneys shall be invested, and the interest accruing thereon be disposed of in manner as by By-Law hereinafter provided.

SEC. 9.—That to provide for the carrying into immediate operation the principles of the Association, and also to provide for its progressive organization and management during the interval pending its incorporation, a Provisional Board of Directors shall be elected from among the Civil Service Employees residing in an analysis.
