

And Whereas, it is provided by the said scheme that a "General Synod of the Church of England in the Dominion of Canada and the Diocese of Newfoundland" shall be formed, and that a first meeting of such Synod shall be held in the City of Toronto on the second Wednesday in September, 1893;

Be it Resolved, that one Clerical and one Lay Delegate be appointed to represent this Diocese at the said meeting in Toronto, with instructions to report to this Synod at its next session.

The communication from the Provincial Synod of Canada was submitted by the Bishop to the Synod. (See Appendix.)

After a lengthy discussion the resolution was *carried*.

At 10.45 the Synod adjourned until 10.25 to-morrow morning.

SECOND DAY.

FRIDAY, JUNE 30th, 1893.

The Synod assembled at 10.30 a.m., immediately after Divine Service.

The appointed office was said by Rev. Canon Beanlands.
