An Act respecting The Prudential Life Insurance Company of Canada.

WHEREAS The Prudential Life Insurance Company of Preamble.
Canada, incorporated by chapter 120 of the statutes of 1907, owing to unavoidable difficulties incident to the perfecting of the financial and other arrangements for the organ-5 ization and carrying on of the business for which the said company was incorporated, has been unable to complete its organization so as to be entitled to a license under The Insurance Act; and whereas the provisional directors of the said s. 69.

R.S., c. 34, company have by their petition prayed that it be enacted as 10 hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. Nothwithstanding anything in section 69 of The Insur-Extension of 15 ance Act, the special Act, chapter 120 of the statutes of 1907, time for incorporating The Prudential Life Insurance Company of license to do Canada, shall be deemed not to have expired and ceased to be in force after the 27th April, 1909, but to have continued and R.S., c. 34, to be in force; and the said company may at any time not s. 69.

20 later than the 27th April, 1910, obtain from the Minister of Finance, under and subject to the provisions of The Insurance Act, the license required by The Insurance Act.

2. If the said company has not obtained such license on the Powers to 27th April, 1910, the powers for carrying on the business of life cease if license not 25 insurance which are granted to the company by the said special obtained. Act, shall then cease and be null and void.
