## BY-LAWS

## Dominion Commercial Travellers' Association,

AS AMENDED DEC. 10, 1887.

## Article I .- Membership.

Ist.—In order to be eligible for membership in this Association a candidate must be a "Commercial Traveller," being a resident, or having a place of business or office in Canada, and not having been expelled from membership by any Commercial Travellers' Association in Canada, for any offence involving a breach of faith with any Company granting privileges to this Association, or on any other justifiable grounds.

2nd.—A Commercial Traveller is a person who travels to sell merchandise, whether Employer or Employee for a Wholesale business, to take orders from Dealers or Manufacturers for Goods which shall be delivered afterwards.

3rd.—Each applicant for Membership shall fill up the required form (see page 7), and be proposed and
