detained near a month by contrary winds; at laft a favourable one came on, which we immediately took the advantage of, and having cleared the Orkney Ifles, we proceeded along the coaft of Scotland, &c. On the 5th of October anchored at the Nore; and the day following moored alongfide the hulk, after a long and tedious abfence of four years, and near three months.
