

nished with a certificate, signed by the President and Secretary of his being a Member of the Quebec Benevolent Society, specifying the relief which the Society allows in the different cases, and that upon the Society's being furnished with a proper Certificate (the form of which shall be annexed) of his being in any of those cases, within the period for which he so shall have paid in advance, the relief so specified will be immediately paid. And in case of the death of such Member, having paid in advance, the surplus of his payments, if any, shall be added to the relief for widows and children, &c. or refunded to whomsoever he may have directed it to be refunded.

ART. 18. No person proposed to be a Member of the Society, who shall have been rejected at the ballot, shall be proposed again more than once.

ART. 19. No Person who shall have been expelled shall be proposed again without he first cause to be deposited all arrears, besides the admission money, and submit his excuse in writing, which shall be disposed of before he can be balloted for.
