

London, April 13.—Mr. Joseph H. Choate, the United States Ambassador, occupied a seat on the bench at the Old Bailey (Central Criminal Court) to-day, beside Justice Grantham, and listened to the trial of a costermonger who was charged with the murder of his paramour. Mr. Choate was welcomed by the sheriff and the corporation officials and Justice Grantham explained to him the criminal procedure before the case began.
