Hon. Bud Cullen (Minister of Manpower and Immigration) moved that Bill C-24, an act respecting immigration to Canada, as reported (with amendments) from the Standing Committee on Labour, Manpower and Immigration, be concurred in.

They did so in part through the instrument of the Special Joint Committee on Immigration Policy which held hearings throughout Canada from May to November, 1975. Some Canadians submitted briefs through their members; others sent them directly to myself or to the department.
