Hon. Bud Cullen (Minister of Manpower and Immigration) moved that Bill C-24, an act respecting immigration to Canada, as reported (with amendments) from the Standing Committee on Labour, Manpower and Immigration, be concurred in.

Motion agreed to.

Mr. Baker (Grenville-Carleton): By order, now.

Mr. Speaker: By order of the House.

Mr. Cullen moved that the bill be read the third time and passed.

He said: Mr. Speaker, when I moved second reading of Bill C-24 I gave a brief historical account of the development of the legislation we now have before us. I pointed out that it was a bill in whose preparation thousands of Canadians had participated. They did so in part through the instrument of the Special Joint Committee on Immigration Policy which held hearings throughout Canada from May to November, 1975. Some Canadians submitted briefs through their members; others sent them directly to myself or to the department.
